To All Survey Bearers:

Enclosed, please find a Residential Permit Parking Petition packet. We've included copies of our informational handouts along several RPP applications (to be used when applying for your individual permits). Please bear in mind that when circulating the petitions on your block you must circulate both the "For" portion of the petition along with the "Against" portion of the petition. If there are vacant or abandoned properties on your block this information should be recorded on the Against Section of the petition. Sometimes people ignore you by not answering their door, this information gets recorded in the against section of the petition.

You must include your name and telephone number in the section marked "Survey Bearer." Do not forget to sign both portions of the petition. In addition, please give us some idea of the total number of houses on the block. Count the number of people who have agree with the program and divide that number by the total the number of homes on the block (EX: 17 signatures / 25 homes = 38%).

Finally, before you mail the petition back to us please take a moment to tell us what hours should be placed on the signs. Our standard hours are: 2HR Parking 8AM-6:30PM / Except Saturday & Sunday. If you do not tell us anything different this is what we will give you.

PETITION FOR RESIDENTIAL PERMIT PARKING

We the undersigned residents (18 years and older) of the -----block of
-----Street, petition City Council and the Philadelphia Parking Authority
to designate our block as part of the Residential Permit Parking Program. The
petition contains signatures of at least (70%) of the households on the block.

We the undersigned residents, understand that the Residential Permit Parking signs must remain
for a trial period of eight months.

A permit costs \$35.00 per vehicle for the first year and \$20.00 for annual renewal.

A "vehicle" is an automobile, motorcycle, van or passenger utility vehicle not exceeding twenty
(20) feet in length.

The permit increases the resident's chances of finding a parking space by stimulating turnover
and eliminating storage of non-residential vehicles, however, it does not guarantee a parking
space.

A permit is only valid on those blocks posted with a permit parking sign having the
corresponding district number.

A permit does not excuse the observance of any traffic regulation except the posted time limit
regulation.

A block is not eligible for permit parking when actual commercial use of property on the ground
floor level of that block exceeds fifty percent.

This petition serves only to inform and advise City Council and the Parking Authority of our
interest in being designated a permit parking block and of our understanding of the program's
regulations. (1 signature per household)
